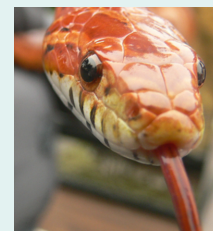

Saturday, May 13, 1:30 – 2:30 p.m. (Ages 7-14. Register by 5/12)

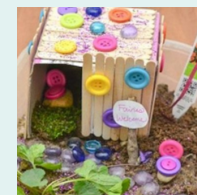
Join Miss Julie to celebrate Venezuelan-American artist Marisol by making a wooden chair sculpture.

Use delicate gold leaf to decorate inside of ceramic bowls.

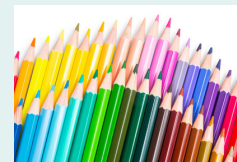
