Muscatine Art Center

Like a kid – or an adult – working on an elaborate LEGO® creation, the team at the Muscatine Art Center is putting into place the pieces to fulfill a vision. There are many projects and activities that are highly visible to the local community and patrons, and these almost always take a great deal of planning— sometimes taking place over several years. One example is the upcoming exhibition, Sean Kenney's Nature Connects® Made with LEGO® bricks. Details about the exhibition and related events are on pages 2 and 3.

Similarly, the commission and creation of the new sculpture, *Expressive Spirit* by David Zahn, and the development and implementation of the landscape plan for the surrounding area has been years in the making. It is a milestone to celebrate the dedication of the sculpture to Mary Jo Stanley on September 9. Special thanks to the University of Iowa's Hancher Auditorium for arranging Step Afrika!'s performance at the Muscatine Art Center. All of those involved in the sculpture commission and the dedication, including the performance, felt honored to celebrate Mary Jo and her love of both visual and performing arts.

Another milestone is the implementation of the Historic Landscape Preservation Plan for the Japanese Garden which is currently in its early stages. Development of the plan gained traction in the spring of 2019 with Associate Professor Heidi Hohmann completing the plan in 2020. The local community can expect to see changes in the garden beginning in spring of 2022. Meanwhile, project consultant, Beth Cody (author of lowa Gardens of the Past), is wrapping up her research, and her findings will be shared in a booklet to be published in early 2022 and during public presentations scheduled for 2022.

After these substantial projects, you may wonder what the Muscatine Art Center plans to do next. That is where we need your help. The **Board of Trustees** is working on a new **Strategic Plan**, and there will be opportunities for completing surveys, participating in discussions, and sharing ideas. We want to know what you appreciate about the Muscatine Art Center

and how we could play a part in addressing community needs. Please be on the lookout for ways to have your voice heard later this year and into 2022.
