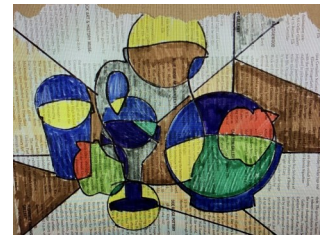
### Happy Birthday, Grant Wood! - *Saturday, February 19, 1:30 - 2:30 p.m.*
